# **MOWING...**

Weeds, Brush. Dense growth of all weeds, vines, brush or other vegetation, including grasses, weeds and other vegetation reached а having height exceeding six (6) inches, except for any cultivated, agricultural commodities which are planted and harvested within the City, provided the same are regularly maintained and otherwise free from the type of offensive vegetation that would constitute a health, safety or fire hazard.

is unlawful for any person to throw, blow, rake or deposit on any street or alley any glass, glass bottle, nails, tacks, wire, cans, trash, garbage, rubbish, litter, offal, animal droppings, grass, leaves, or any other debris likely to be washed into the storm sewer and clog the storm sewer, or any substance likely to injure any person, animal or vehicle.

# CLEAN UP WEEK

This is the time to get your yards cleaned up ... junk or junk vehicles moved / appliances etc.

The City will have dumpsters / trailers setting behind City Hall on Wednesday, June 1. In the dumpsters, you can put "junk" items such as couches, chairs.

THESE ITEMS DO NOT GO IN THE DUMPSTERS - Tires, Appliances, Electronics, TV's ... a place will be designated for these.

If you can't haul the items, call City Hall to get on a list for the items to be picked up on the morning of Saturday, June 4th

After this week, if your yard is a mess or junk vehicles or junk setting around, a letter will sent giving you a certain amount of time to get it all cleaned up and after that date nuisance fines could be assessed.
